1. (12 points) Find the inverse Laplace transforms of
(a) $F(s)=\frac{3}{s^{2}+4}$
(b) $F(s)=\frac{2}{s^{2}+3 s-4}$
2. (12 points) Using the Laplace transform, find the solution to the initial value problem

$$
y^{\prime \prime}+4 y=\sin (t)-u_{2 \pi}(t) \sin (t-2 \pi), \quad y(0)=0, \quad y^{\prime}(0)=0
$$

where $u_{c}(t)$ is the unit step function equal to 1 for $t \geq c$ and 0 otherwise.
3. (12 points) Find the solution to the initial value problem

$$
y^{\prime \prime}+2 y^{\prime}+2 y=\delta(t-\pi), \quad y(0)=1, \quad y^{\prime}(0)=0
$$

where $\delta$ is the Dirac delta function.
4. (12 points) Let

$$
f(x)=\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} b_{n} \sin (n \pi x), \quad \text { where } \quad b_{n}=2 \int_{0}^{1} x^{2} \sin (n \pi x) d x
$$

(a) Is $f(x)$ an even function, an odd function, or neither?
(b) What is the period of $f(x)$ ?
(c) Graph $f(x)$ for $0 \leq x \leq 1$.
(d) What is $f(1.5)$ ?
(Hint: Using (a) and (b), consider what the graph of $f(x)$ for all $x$ looks like.)
5. (12 points) Consider the heat conduction problem

$$
\begin{gathered}
u_{x x}=4 u_{t}, \quad 0<x<2, \quad t>0 \\
u(0, t)=0, \quad u(2, t)=0, \quad t>0 \\
u(x, 0)=2 \sin (\pi x / 2)-\sin (\pi x)+4 \sin (2 \pi x)
\end{gathered}
$$

(a) Find the solution $u(x, t)$.
(b) What is the steady state solution as $t$ goes to infinity?
6. (12 points) Find the solution $u(x, t)$ to the wave equation problem

$$
\begin{array}{lll}
4 u_{x x}=u_{t t}, & 0<x<\pi, & t>0 \\
u(0, t)=0, & u(\pi, t)=0, & t>0
\end{array}
$$

where

$$
\begin{aligned}
u(x, 0) & =0 \\
u_{t}(x, 0) & =3 \sin (x)
\end{aligned}
$$

for $0 \leq x \leq \pi$.
